Collaborative Coach is a personalized, interactive, asynchronous experience that offers 1:1 coaching in a safe and supportive environment.

Educators receive direct access to a Collaborative Coach who provides program-specific virtual coaching and feedback through the Collaborative Classroom Learning Portal.

Who Should Register

Collaborative Coach is for educators seeking coaching support for implementing Being a Reader[®], Caring School Community®, or the SIPPS® program, as well as adults participating in SEEDS of Learning® professional learning.

Cohorts are offered for fall and winter. Custom, district-specific cohorts are also available upon request.

Fee: \$550 per person for one 10-week cohort. \$1,100 per person for one 20-week cohort. Optional college credit available.









Refining Educator Practice, Supporting Leaders
